

Our Daily Koala Class Program:

- **7am** Centre opens
- Mixed group play with Possum and Joey children in the Possum room – free choice of activities
- **8.30am** Koalas active play outside
Progressive morning tea occurs during this time
- **10.20am** Slow transition inside to class group music time and group language time based around intentional teaching and the interests and needs of the children.
- **10.50am** Table activities and learning through play involving fine motor, sensory play, imaginative play, craft, literacy and numeracy.*
- **12.00pm** Lunch in small groups at tables with a focus on social interaction and healthy eating
- **12.30pm** Rest Time Sleepers rest inside whilst quiet outdoor activities are provided for children not wishing to sleep
- **2pm** Class regroups for quiet table activities inside with a fine motor focus.
Progressive afternoon tea occurs during this time
- **3pm** Children's news time and games
- **3.30pm** Transition outside to gross motor activities and play
- **4pm** Possums join mixed age group play outside with Koala and Joey children
- **5pm** Mixed age group play inside with Possum and Joey children – stories, songs and late snack followed by free choice activities
- **6pm** Centre closes

*Examples of play based experiences: water play, construction with wooden blocks, easel painting, gardening, music and instruments, clay modelling, cooking using our garden produce, writing and drawing, puzzles, craft, threading, design, science experiments, books, home corner and imaginative play, sensory and textural exploration

Our daily transitions are intentional, meaningful learning experiences that enrich our routines and support children's development

This routine is a guide for children, families and educators and may vary depending on a variety of circumstances such as current interests, events and weather conditions
